Unit Inspection (Annual)

Purpose of Policy

To provide members with guidelines for annual unit inspections.

Policy

- 1. Unit inspections will be conducted on an annual basis by a neutral third party hired by the board of directors.
- 2. The focus of the inspection will be to determine if there are any issues detrimental to the Co-op, either by impacting the Health and Safety of the community and/or compromising the value and long-term viability of the property. Such as:
 - Health and Safety issues:
 - o Fire Hazard
 - o Pests
 - o Mold
 - Property Damage
 - o Non-approved changes to the unit
 - Structural damage
- 3. Members will be notified in writing at least one week prior to the upcoming inspection. All unit inspections will be scheduled at a mutually agreed upon time.
- 4. Member is required to permit access to the unit by the board appointed inspector, as per the Occupancy Agreement, Section 25 **Right to Enter**, subsection 25.03 Entry for non-emergency.
- 5. Failure of the member to show up or to allow access at the mutually agreed upon time, will result in a fee to cover the cost of the tradesperson's time and an immediate rescheduling of the appointment will be required.
- 6. As a follow-up to the inspection, the Co-op will submit to the member a list of any repairs and/or cleaning required that are the responsibility of the member. All other repairs will be prioritized and coordinated by the Maintenance Coordinator.
- 7. Failure of the member to allow access for the follow up repairs at a mutually agreed upon time, may result in a fine to cover the cost of the tradesperson's time and an immediate rescheduling of the appointment will be required.
- 8. Failure to permit access for inspections and/or repairs will be considered **Conduct Detrimental to the Co-op** (Rule 5.2)

Procedures needed to carry out the policy

- 1. If a member is unable to schedule a mutually agreed upon time for their unit inspection, they may designate another person to provide access.
- 2. Should you need to reschedule the inspection or the repairs, 24 hours notice is required.
